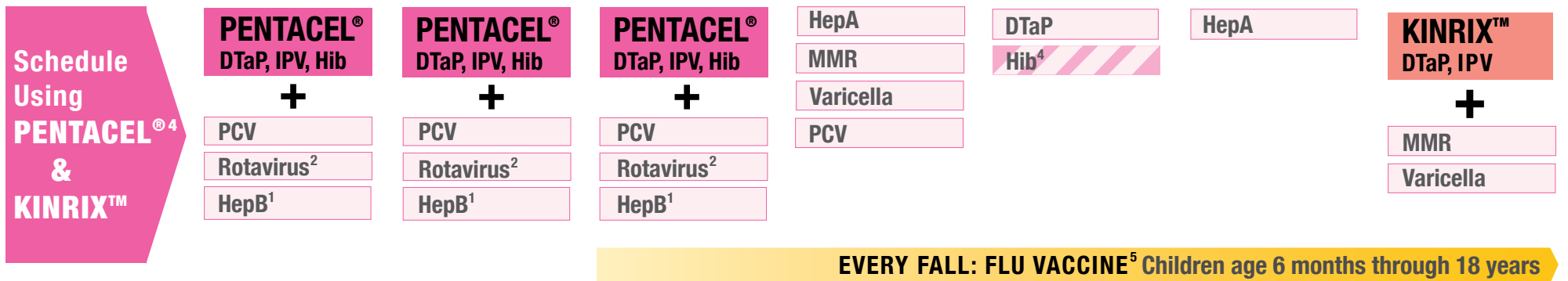
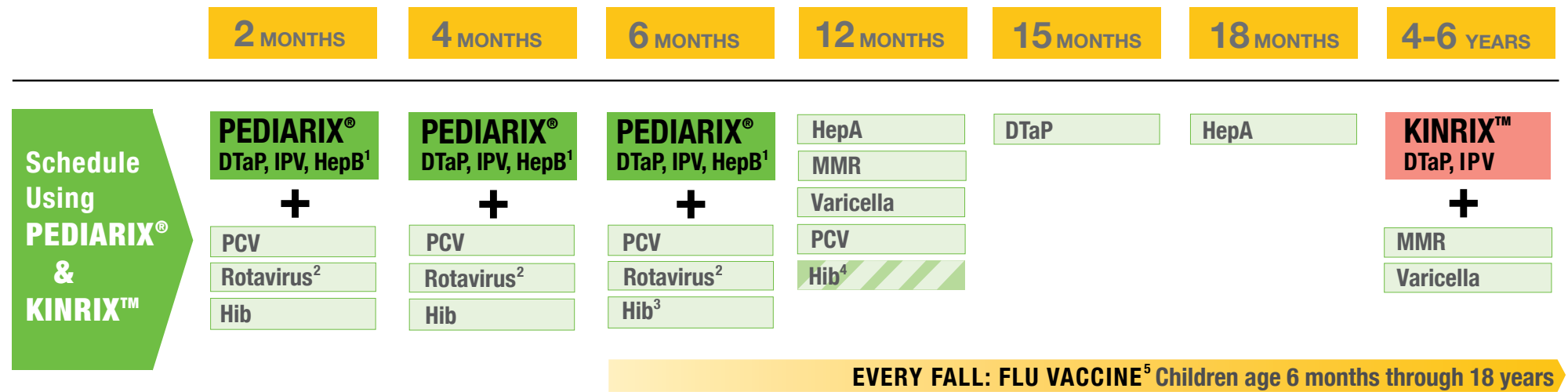


Immunization Schedule with Combination Vaccines



Combination vaccines are not identical.

Make sure the vaccine you administer contains the antigens on the doctor's order.

Keep it simple, stick with the same product.

¹ A dose of Hepatitis B vaccine is not necessary at 4 months if doses are given at birth and 2 months but may be included as part of a combination vaccine.

² The rotavirus vaccines differ in number of doses and timing. Check the package insert.

³ This six month Hib dose is not indicated if Pedvax HIB® and/or COMVAX® are used exclusively for the 2 and 4 month infant doses.

⁴ Except for high-risk children, temporarily defer the booster dose of Hib.

⁵ Influenza vaccine is available in thimerosal-free options. See California Health and Safety Code § 124172.
