* For those who have not had the full series by age 18 years, give two doses 1 month apart at 12 years

† Offered to high-risk groups only

‡ Administered after at least 2 doses of IPV (Preventor)

§ Two doses given at least four weeks apart are recommended for children who are getting a full series for the first time. See vaccine recommendations for details www.cdc.gov/vaccines/imz/immunization
